OrthoBioMed system and courses exploitation agreement between contributors

Usage of OrthoBoMed system and courses developed during the project is granted to all the institutions who have contributed to this development (see attached list).

OrthoBioMed learning environment will be hosted and maintained by Instituto de Biomecanica de Valencia [IBV] for at least 24 months after the end of the project.

Maintenance does not include users' management. It will remain under the responsibility of each contributor to manage his users. Teacher's accounts will be created to all partners so they can enrol the learners and perform the tutoring in their institution.

Usage of OrthoBioMed system and existing courses will be free for all contributors for non commercial use. Commercial use includes any activity resulting in financial revenues.

Any new course developed by one of the contributor after official end of the project will remain his property.

This does not include corrections or updates of existing courses. Corrections and updates can only be made (or agreed) by the original authors.

Agreement for any commercial use of all or part of the system should be requested to all original contributors before its usage. EACEA will also be informed.

Once official request has been sent, the contributors will have one month to reply. A special agreement will have to be approved between the contributors in order to define the royalties and usage rights. If a contributor does not answer within one month, he will not take part of the new agreement and will not receive subsequent royalties. In any case, original contents should remain untouched and reference to authors must be mentioned.

Two years after the project end an amendment to this agreement will be signed for the future exploitation, upgrade and update of the courses. There are two options: IBV continues maintaining the system or each contributor is entitled to host a copy of the whole system and courses content on his own WEB infrastructure.
